## **CALL FOR ABSTRACTS/PAPER/ORAL or POSTER PRESENTATIONS**

Abstracts (about 300 words) or full-length papers (about 3000 words) in English/Hindi aligned with the conference themes/sub-the measure invited for Oral Presentation/Poster Presentation/Publication only mode.

### **NOTE:**

- The Abstract/Paper must be original, unpublished, and should not be under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- Abstract/Paper must be prepared in MS Word, Times New Roman, 12-point font, double line-spacing, bold headings, and APA-7<sup>th</sup> Edition referencing style (applicable for Full-length Papers).
- The first page of Abstract/Paper must include: Full name(s) of author(s), Designation, Affiliation, Contact number, E-mail ID(s), and Participation mode (Oral + Publication/ Poster + Publication/ Publication only).
- Abstract/Paper must be emailed to [info.icrasetm@gmail.com](mailto:info.icrasetm@gmail.com).
- Decision on acceptance will be communicated within 5 days so receiving the Abstract/Paper.
- All selected abstracts and full-length papers will be published in the conference proceedings, bearing an ISBN number.
- Full-length papers will be recommended for publication in peer-reviewed/referred IRAJ journals.
- A select number of screened papers will also be recommended to authors for publication in SCOPUS or ABDC-indexed journals. However, the responsibility for APC and peer review will be managed solely by the respective journal.

# GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTATION

## Oral Presentation

1. The oral presentation will be of 10 minutes duration with a maximum of 10-15 slides.
2. The sequence and arrangement of slides are as follows: Title(1slide); Introduction (1 slide); Aim/objectives (1 slide); Methodology/ Study design/ Literature Survey(2-3slides);Results/Discussion/Key findings/Major observation (4-5 slides); Summary/ Conclusion/ Recommendations (1 slide); Reference (1 slide).
3. Use a font size of 24 for contents, which should have no more than eight lines of text per slide.
4. The facilities for the PowerPoint and over head projections will be available at the conference.

## Poster Presentation

1. The poster is to be printed in 4 feet (h) X 3feet (w)(standard portrait format).
2. The poster must be well organized in columns. Keep the text brief. Avoid long blocks of text. Use bullet points.
3. Present numerical data in the form of graphs, charts, or simple tables. A maximum of 5 tables/diagrams/graphic representations is allowed.
4. Poster must be on a white background, fonts and letters must be legible and readable from at least 2 feet distance.
5. The presenting authorize expected to be present with their posters for discussion.
